David led the people not just as a soldier, but also in worship. He wrote half of the book of Psalms. His best-known song is Psalm 23.



In difficult times of life, David was careful to do right. When life was easy, David was careless and went badly wrong. Not only did he take Uriah's wife, he let Uriah be killed to try to cover it up. [2 Samuel 11] The prophet Nathan helped David to turn back to God and be forgiven. [2 Samuel 12]

- what he says he will do [Psalm 51v13-17].
