At the time of Noah people lived for much longer than they do now.  
 Noah was \_\_\_\_\_ years old when the flood came. [Genesis 7v11]

In the story of Noah and the flood,

**Noah** is a picture of Jesus - doing what is right [Genesis 7v1] and  
making a way for people to be saved.

**The boat** (ark) is a picture of Jesus - only those who trusted their lives  
to it were saved from God's judgement.

**The flood** is a picture of Jesus - coming suddenly and unexpectedly.  
[Matthew 24v37-39; 24v44]

**The rainbow** is a picture of Jesus - a sign that God loves us and will  
keep his promises.
