



# Aaron



The Israelites had left Egypt.

God gave them laws and instructions about how to live.

God chose people to be priests to help the people to learn and to live rightly.



God told Moses to separate his brother Aaron and his sons from the people of Israel so that they would \_\_\_\_\_ as \_\_\_\_\_.

Aaron is chosen to be Moses' partner in God's work.

*Exodus 4v14-16*

Moses and Aaron deal with the stubborn king.

*5-11*

Aaron is appointed as High priest.

*28-29*

Aaron goes against God by making an idol.

*32*

God gives instructions for Aaron and the priests. *Leviticus 1-27*

God shows that Aaron is his chosen priest. *Numbers 16-17*



**PRIESTS** - The priests helped the people in bringing their worship of gifts and sacrifices to God.

They taught the people how to live clean lives - clean from sin, disease, and things that would spoil their bodies, their homes, their families, their communities or their friendship with God.

When things went wrong in any of these areas, the priests had God's way of helping things to be put right again.

The Israelites had Aaron as high priest to go into God's presence for them.

We now have Jesus as our high priest. [Hebrews 4v14-16]

What does this mean for us?

Aaron brought special sacrifices so that the Israelites could be right with God. [Hebrews 9v7, and see Leviticus 16]

Jesus brought his perfect sacrifice to put us right with God.  
[Hebrews 9v11-12]

There is no need for priests like Aaron now that Jesus is our high priest. Read Hebrews 7v24-28. Which part is particularly special to you?
